Regulations for Public Liturgical Services and Church Events in Hamburg

⚙️ With your participation in this liturgical service, you are confirming your consent with the following regulations.

In order to protect and not endanger other participants, you are prohibited to attend the service if you have unspecific general symptoms, i.e., fever, respiratory problems or if you are positive for coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) or under quarantine.

We also ask you to observe the following protocols:

⚙️ According to the official state requirements, **the number of participants is limited** due to the required minimum distances to be observed. *Please note the registration procedure, which may be regulated separately.*



Admission is not possible when the required number of participants is reached.



Follow the instructions of the ushers. Please **use only those designated and marked places/pews.**



Always observe physical distancing and keep at least **1.5 to 2-meter distance** from fellow churchgoers at all times inside and outside the church.



You need to wear a medical or FFP-2 mask throughout the whole duration of liturgical service.



Please be aware and observe the **general cough and sneeze etiquettes.**



Please **bring your own** liturgical song book/prayer book.



Please **cough or sneeze into the crook of your arm** or inner elbow.



Please **avoid small gatherings and build-ups** before, during and after the worship.



Please **wash or disinfect your hands** before entering the church.



Parishioners must provide **names and contact details** at the entrance for feasible contact tracing



Please follow these rules and regulations. Violations can lead to expulsion from the church. Your participation in the liturgical worship is at your own risk.
